ORDINANCE NO. 1.

An ordinance annexing certain territory to the village of Nielsville.

The Village Council of the Village of Nielsville, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory or lands, being the Northwest Quarter(NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter(NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty(30), Township One Hundred Forty-seven(147), Range Forty-eight(48), West, abutting upon the incorporated village of Nielsville, be and the same are hereby annexed to such village and shall become a part of such village as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof.
