### PUBLIC NOTICE

ORDINANCE NO. 15  
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING  
FOR THE COMBINATION OF  
THE OFFICES OF VILLAGE  
CLERK AND VILLAGE  
TREASURER AND PROVID-  
ING FOR ANNUAL AUDITS.

THE VILLAGE OF RACINE  
ORDAINS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted by Laws 1961, Ch. 230 the offices of clerk and treasurer in the village of Racine, Mower County, Minnesota, are hereby combined in the office of clerk-treasurer.

Section 2. Beginning with the year in which this ordinance becomes effective and each year thereafter, there shall be an audit of the village's financial affairs by the Public Examiner or a Public Accountant in accordance with minimum auditing procedures prescribed by the Public Examiner.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective at the expiration of the term of the incumbent treasurer or when an earlier vacancy occurs.
