ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of all that part of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2), Township One Hundred Thirty-nine (139), Range Forty-five (45), described as follows: Beginning at a point on the South line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 2, Township 139, Range 45, which point is 17 rods west of the Southeast corner of said Northeast Quarter; thence North 16 rods; thence West 10 rods; thence South 16 rods; thence East 10 rods, to the point of beginning, situated in Clay County, Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Hawley ordains as follows:

Sec. 1. The following described land owned by L.C. Enfield and Vivian Enfield, husband and wife, abutting said Village, all of which is located in the County of Clay, State of Minnesota, is hereby added to, taken into, and made part of the Village of Hawley, to wit:

All that part of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2), Township One Hundred Thirty-nine (139), Range Forty-five (45), described as follows: Beginning at a point on the South line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 2, Township 139, Range 45, which point is 17 rods west of the Southeast corner of said Northeast Quarter; thence North 16 rods; thence West 10 rods; thence South 16 rods; thence East 10 rods, to the point of beginning, situated in Clay County, Minnesota.

Sec. 2. On this Ordinance taking effect the corporate limits and boundary lines of the Village of Hawley shall be extended to include the easterly, northerly, and westerly lines and sides of said land.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its publication in the official newspaper.
