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

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ORDINANCE NO. 457

**AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING
CERTAIN PROPERTY ABUT-
TING THE CITY OF ANOKA,
TO THE CITY OF ANOKA.**

The Commission of the City of
Anoka do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to a proper
and sufficient petition by Anoka-
Hennepin School District No. 11,
by Anoka-Hennepin District No.
11 School Board, by Dr. David
Spencer, Chairman, Melvin Jac-
obson, Vice Chairman, L. John
Buyse, Clerk, Nils Sandell,
Treasurer, Carl Swenson, Direc-
tor and Leland Sorteberg, Direc-
tor, the owner of a tract, piece
and parcel of land abutting the
City of Anoka, Minnesota, and
described as follows, to-wit:

The North one half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of
the Northwest one quarter
(NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, Town-
ship 32, Range 24, Anoka
County, Minnesota; also the
North 100 feet of the South
one half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of said North-
west one quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of
Section 31, Township 32,
Range 24; also subject to an
easement for roadway pur-
poses over the Easterly 33
feet thereof for County State
Aid Highway No. 7; also, all
that part of Government Lot
1, Section 36, Township 32,
Range 25, Anoka County,

Minnesota, lying North of
the westerly extension of the
South line of the North 100
feet of the South one half
(S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest one
quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section
31, Township 32, Range 24;

to have said territory annexed
to the City of Anoka, the Com-
mission having determined that
the land described in said peti-
tion abuts on the City of Anoka,
is not included in any other
municipality, does not exceed
200 acres in area, and that the
annexation to the City of Anoka
will be to the best interests of
the City of Anoka and of the
territory described in the peti-
tion, said tract, piece and parcel
of land is hereby declared to be
annexed to and to be an addi-
tion to the City of Anoka.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall
be in full force and effect thirty
(30) days from date of publica-
tion.
