

ORDINANCE 227

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF EAST GRAND FORKS, MINNESOTA, TO IN-CLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND OWNED BY AND ABUT-TING UPON THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE SAID CITY, LOCATED IN THE N% OF THE SW4 OF SECTION 36, TOWN-SHIP 152 NORTH OF RANGE 50, TOTALLING 19.03 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

The City Council of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, do Ordain as follows:
Section 1. The corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include that certain unplatted tract of land owned by the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, and abutting upon the corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, and south of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

A part of the North half of the Southwest Quarter (N½ SW¼) of Section Thirty-six (36), Townshin One Hundred Fifty-two (152) North, Range Fifty (50) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, which part is described as follows,

Beginning at a point on the East-West quarter section line of Section Thirty-six (36). Township One Hundred Fifty-two (152) North, Range Fifty (50) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian which point is 1198.12 feet distant easterly from the West line of said Section Thirty-six (36) and which point is the true point of beginning; thence proceeding southerly on a line lying parallel to and 1193.12 feet distant easterly from the West line of Section Thirty-six (36) for a distance of Forty (40.00) feet distant southerly from the East-West Quarter (40,00) feet distant southerly from the Said Section line in the said Section Thirty-six (36); thence deflecting right and proceeding westerly on a line lying parallel to and Forty (40) feet distant southerly from the said East-West Quarter (40) Section line for a distance of 585.44 feet to a point lying 627.68 feet distant ensterly from the West line of said Section Thirty-six (36) thence deflecting left and proceeding southerly on a line lying parallel to and 627.68 feet distant ensterly from the West line of said Section Thirty-six (36) for a distance of 1080.73 feet more or less to the north-west corner of Outlot 46 of Anditor's Plat of Outlots Seventeen (17) through Sixty-four (64), Section Thirty-six (36), Township One Hundred Fifty-two (152) North, Range Fifty (50) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian; thence deflecting left and proceeding easterly from the east-west Quarter Quarter (12 %) Section Thirty-six (36), for a distance of 760.00 feet; thence deflecting left and proceeding left and proceeding northerly, on a line lying parallel to and 204.00 feet distant northerly from the east-west Quarter Quarter (14 %) Section Thirty-six (36), for a distance of 760.00 feet; thence deflecting left and proceeding left to the true point of beginning, said point of beginning, said tract being comprised of 80'61 acres lying wholly within the North Half of the South-west Quarter (1½ SW½) of Section Thirty-six (36),

Township One Hundred Fifty-two (152) North, Range Fifty (50) West of the Fifty Principal Meridian, County of Polk and State of Minnesota,

Section 2. The City Council hereby determines:

- a. That the West and North boundaries of said tract of land abut the corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, and is not included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough;
- b. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, and of the territory affected;
- c. That said tract of land is suitably condition for mun-icipal government;
- d. That said tract of land is urban in character;
- e. That said tract of land com-prises 19.03 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the tract of land described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Polk County and the Town Clerk of Creek and the Town Clerk of Grand Forks Township.

Section 5. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication, and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 4.
