ORDINANCE NO. 1171

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY WHICH THE PERIMETER OF THE AREA IS 60 PERCENT OR MORE BOUNDARY BY THE CITY OF AUSTIN.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the perimeter of the area is 60 percent or more bounded by the City of Austin, and is deemed to be urban in character,

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Austin served notice of intention upon the Board of Supervisors of Lansing Township, Nowar County, Minnesota, on August 14, 1968,

AND WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board within the 60 day period as required by Chapter 414.032, Subdivision 3, Minnesota Session Laws 1969;

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: The corporate limits of the City of Austin are hereby extended to include the unplatted ^{and platted} land described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City of Austin as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Beginning at the N.W. corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 103 North, Range 18 West, Nowar County, Minnesota, thence southerly along the west line of said one quarter until this line intersects the extension of the south line of Lot 7, Block 2, Edson's Addition extended westerly, this point also being on the centerline of 3th Street N.E., thence easterly along this line to the southeast corner of said Lot 7, thence southerly in a straight line to the southwest corner of Lot 10, of said Block 2, thence easterly on the south line of said Lot 10, one hundred feet, thence southerly on a line parallel to the east line of said Block 2 a distance of 100 feet, this point being on the south right-of-way line of 17th Avenue N.E., thence easterly on said south right-of-way line a distance of 20 feet to the northwest corner of Lot 6, Block 3, Edson's Addition, thence southerly along the west line of said Lot 6 a distance of 161 feet to the southwest corner of said Lot 6, thence easterly on the south line of Block 3 a distance of 350 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 12, said Block 3, thence northerly along the east line said Lot 12, a distance of 161 feet to the northeast corner of said Lot 12, this point also being on the right-of-way line of 17th Avenue N.E., thence easterly along the south right-of-way line until this line intersects the west right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul & Pacific Railroad, thence southerly along this west right-of-way line until it intersects the north right-of-way line of Federal Highway 490, thence southeasterly along the north right-of-way of Federal Highway 490 until it intersects the east right-of-way line of said railroad, thence northerly along this east right-of-way line of said railroad until it intersects the south line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 103 North, Range 18 West, thence easterly along this south line 198.4 feet to a point that is 33 feet west of the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, thence northerly on a line parallel to the east line of said one quarter a distance of 208.2 feet to a point on the east right-of-way of County Highway No. 10, thence southwesterly on the east right-of-way of said County Highway to a point 33 feet north and 106.9 feet west of the SE corner of said one quarter section, thence westerly on a line parallel to the south line of said one quarter section to the west right-of-way line of said railroad, thence southerly along the west right-of-way line of said railroad until it intersects the northeast corner of outlet 1, Edson's Addition, thence westerly along the

north line of said outlet 1, a distance of 103.7 feet, thence southerly to a point which intersects the south line of Lot 11, Block 4, Edson's Addition extended easterly 350 feet from the SE corner of said Lot 11, Block 4, Edson's Addition, thence northerly on the east line of said Lot 11 a distance of 200 feet, this point also being the southeast corner of Lot 7 of said Block 4, thence westerly along the south line of said Lot 7 to the southwest corner of said lot, thence westerly across 9th Street N.E. to the southeast corner of Lot 12, Block 2, Edson's Addition, thence easterly along the south line of Lot 12 and Lot 6 of said Block until this line extended intersects the centerline of 9th Drive NE, thence northeasterly along the centerline of 9th Drive NE until this line intersects the north line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 35, thence westerly on this line to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The City Recorder is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County in which the property is located, the Township Clerk of the Township in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and filing certified copies as directed in Section 2.

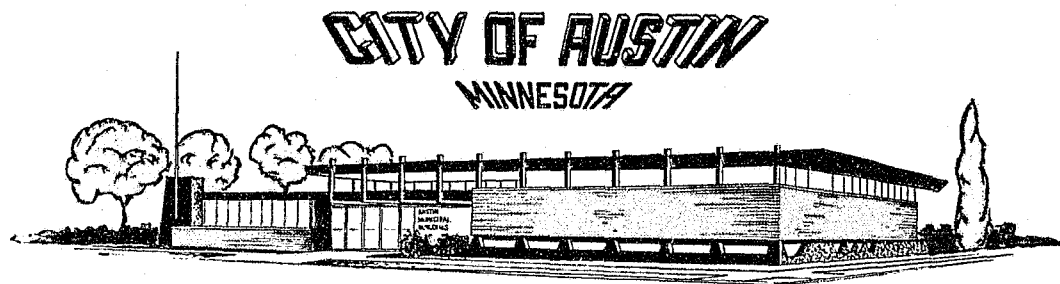

ORDINANCE NO. 1171

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY WHICH THE PERIMETER OF THE AREA IS 60 PERCENT OR MORE BORDERED BY THE CITY OF AUSTIN.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the perimeter of the area is 60 percent or more bordered by the City of Austin, and is deemed to be urban in character,

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Austin served notice of intention upon the Board of Supervisors of Lansing Township, Mower County, Minnesota, on August 4, 1969,

AND WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board within the 60 day period as required by Chapter 414.033, Subdivision 3, Minnesota Session Laws 1969;

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: The corporate limits of the City of Austin are hereby extended to include the unplatted and platted land described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City of Austin as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Beginning at the NW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 103 North, Range 18 west, Mower County, Minnesota, thence southerly along the west line of said one quarter until this line intersects the extension of the south line of Lot 7, Block 2, Edson's Addition extended westerly, this point also being on the center-line of 8th Street NE, thence easterly along this line to the southeast corner of said Lot 7, thence southerly in a straight line to the southwest corner of Lot 16, of said Block 2, thence easterly on the south line of said Lot 16, one hundred feet, thence southerly on a line parallel to the east line of said Block 2 a distance of 160 feet, this point being on the south right-of-way line of 17th Avenue NE, thence easterly on said south right-of-way line a distance of 20 feet to the northwest corner of Lot 5, Block 3, Edson's Addition, thence southerly along the west line of said Lot 5 a distance of 161 feet to the southwest corner of said Lot 6, thence easterly on the south line of Block 3 a distance of 350 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 12, said Block 3, thence northerly along the east line said Lot 12, a distance of 161 feet to the northeast corner of said Lot 12, this point also being on the right-of-way line of 17th Avenue NE, thence easterly along the south right-of-way line until this line intersects the west right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul & Pacific Railroad, thence southerly along this west right-of-way line until it intersects the north right-of-way line of Federal Highway #90, thence southeasterly along the north right-of-way of Federal Highway #90 until it intersects the east right-of-way line of said railroad, thence northerly along this east right-of-way line of said railroad until it intersects the south line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 103 North, Range 18 West, thence easterly along this south line 198.4 feet to a point that is 33 feet west of the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, thence northerly on a line parallel to the east line of said one quarter a distance of 205.2 feet to a point on the east right-of-way of County Highway No. 16, thence southwesterly on the east right-of-way of said County Highway to a point 33 feet north and 166.9 feet west of the SE

corner of said one quarter section, thence westerly on a line parallel to the south line of said one quarter section to the west right-of-way line of said railroad, thence southerly along the west right-of-way line of said railroad until it intersects the northeast corner of Outlot 1, Edson's Addition, thence westerly along the north line of said Outlot 1, a distance of 106.7 feet, thence southerly to a point which intersects the south line of Lot 11, Block 4, Edson's Addition extended easterly 350 feet from the SE corner of said Lot 11, Block 4, Edson's Addition, thence westerly 350 feet on the extended line of said Lot 11 to the SE corner of said Lot 11, thence northerly on the east line of said Lot 11 a distance of 200 feet, this point also being the southeast corner of Lot 7 of said Block 4, thence westerly along the south line of said Lot 7 to the southwest corner of said lot, thence westerly across 9th Street NE to the southeast corner of Lot 21, Block 2, Edson's Addition, thence westerly along the south line of Lot 21 and Lot 6 of said Block until this line extended intersects the centerline of 8th Drive NE, thence northeasterly along the centerline of 8th Drive NE until this line intersects the north line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 35, thence westerly on this line to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The City Recorder is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County in which the property is located, the Township Clerk of the Township in which the property is located and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and filing certified copies as directed in Section 2.
