ORDINANCE NO. 63

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO THE
INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERTOWN,
MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, a certain Petition, dated the 2nd day of September, 1969, and requesting annexation to the Village of Watertown of certain territory described below, was duly presented to the Village Council of the Village of Watertown, on the 2nd day of September, 1969, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.03; and

WHEREAS, The Village Council finds that said Petition was signed by all of the owners of said lands and is suitable and proper in all respects; and

WHEREAS, copies of said Petition were duly forwarded on September 3, 1969, to the Clerk of the Town Board of the Township of Watertown, the Carver County Board of Commissioners, the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, and the Minnesota Secretary of State, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, more than thirty days have elapsed since the dates of said filing and no objections have been made in writing, or otherwise, to the Village of Watertown as to the annexation proposed by said Petition:

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that a copy of said Petition was duly mailed, as required by law, to the Town Board of the Town of Watertown, the Carver County Board of Commissioners, the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, and the Minnesota Secretary of State, and that no objection to the

proposed annexation has been made by any of said parties or filed with the Village Council; that the territory described below abuts upon the present corporate limits of the Village of Watertown; that said lands do not exceed 200 acres in area; that said lands are not now included in any other municipality; that said lands are conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal Government; and that the annexation of said lands would be to the best interests of the Village of Watertown and the Territory to be annexed.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Watertown are hereby extended to encompass and embrace all of the territory described as follows, to-wit:

Outlot Seventy (70); that part of Jackson Street adjacent to and abutting outlots Seventy (70) and Seventy-one (71) between the center line of White Street and the South-westerly line of Stevens Street; that part of Stevens Street adjacent to and abutting said Outlot 70; and the Southeasterly 33 feet of White Street, adjacent to and abutting Outlot 71; according to the plat of the Village of Watertown on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for the County of Carver and State of Minnesota.

The above situated upon the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6-117-25.

Section 3. Piling The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, Minnesota Secretary of State, and the Carver County Board of Commissioners, as required by law.



described land under the authority granted by said location.

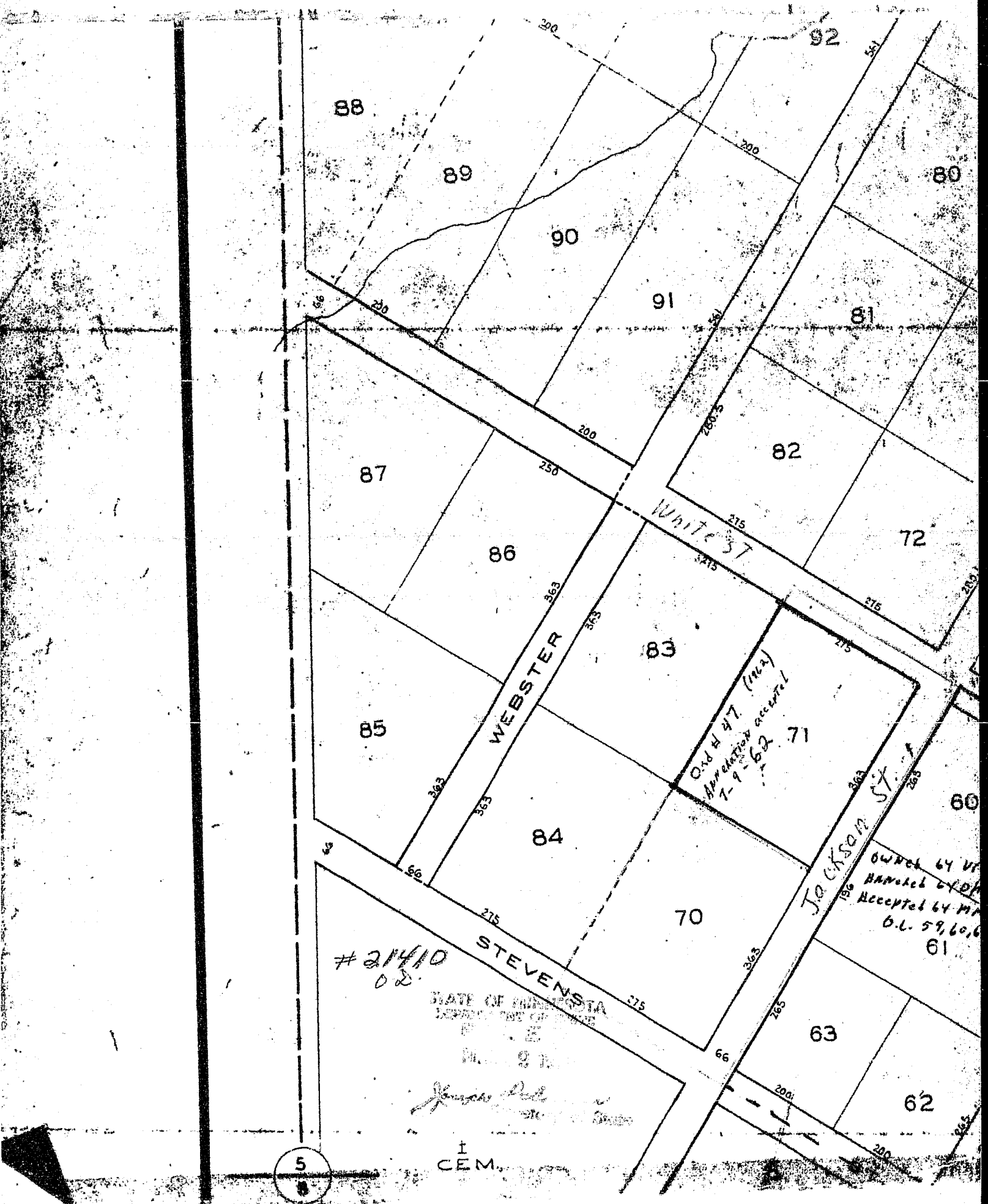
