ORDINANCE NO. 349

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1.

WHEREAS the following described property situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

A parcel of land which is comprised of Lots 1 and 2 of Heinze Addition to Thief River Falls and part of Gov't. Lot 11, Section 4, T.153N, R.43W bounded as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of said Gov't. Lot 11; thence West along the North line of said Gov't. Lot 11 to the northwest corner thereof; thence South along the West line of said Gov't. Lot 11 to the centerline of the Red Lake River; thence meandering along the centerline of said River to an intersection with the South line of said Lot 2 extended; thence East along the South line of said Lot 2 to the East line of said Gov't. Lot 11; thence North along said East line to the point of beginning; containing 15.9 acres more or less,

is completely surrounded by land within the municipal limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to M.S.A. 414.033, Subd. 4 the above described property is hereby declared to be incorporated within and annexed to the City of Thief River Falls, Minnesota.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing with the Municipal Commission, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
