PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, according to the terms of an act of the Congress of the United States, entitled: "An act to provide for the promotion of vocational rehabilitation of persons disabled in industry or otherwise and their return to civil employment" and approved by the president; June second, 1920, the benefits of a federal appropriation will be made available in extending the work of re-education and placement of our citizens who have been disabled by industrial accident or otherwise.

AND WHEREAS, there was not on June second 1920, has not been since that date, and will not be on or before December thirty-first 1920, a regular session of the legislature of Minnesota,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Governor of Minnesota, complying with the terms of said Act do hereby accept on behalf of Minnesota the provisions of the act.

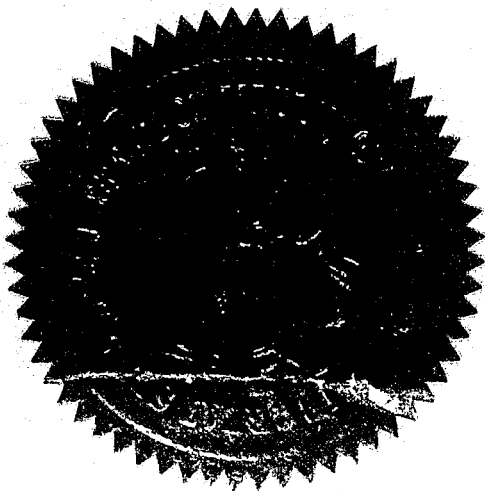
I hereby empower and direct the state board of vocational education to cooperate with the federal board for vocational education in the administration of the provisions of the act.

I hereby certify that a plan of cooperation between the state board for vocational education and the department of labor and industries has been formulated and approved by me; also that by the provisions of Chapter 365, Laws 1919, vocational rehabilitation of disabled persons is now being carried on in this state and that an appropriation has been made for the work during the fiscal year beginning July first, 1920.


I hereby appoint the state treasurer as custodian for the appropriation under the Federal Act.
