

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the wise use of credit is a necessity for all consumers, with consumer credit totaling more than 103 billion dollars; and

WHEREAS, professional bill collectors have joined in an effort to urge consumers to spend wisely, use credit with caution, and pay promptly; and

WHEREAS, the consumer who pays his bills on time has peace of mind; and

WHEREAS, the consumer who uses credit judiciously buys his right to use credit again; and

WHEREAS, this national movement, sponsored by the American Collectors Association, an international association of nearly 2700 bonded collection agencies including 60 offices serving Minnesotans is designed to help improve the credit position of our citizens

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lovander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 2-8, 1970, as

PAY YOUR BILLS WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to use their credit with caution and pay their bills promptly.
