NOW, THEREFORE, I, HAROLD LeVANDER, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 19, 1970, as

ALL MINNESOTA FOODS WEEK IN ALL MINNESOTA SCHOOLS

and urge all schools of this State to participate in serving a complete menu of foods produced and processed in Minnesota.
