- WHEREAS, the United States Jaycees is an organization of young men dedicated to community betterment and individual development; and
- WHEREAS, in Minnesota there are over 188 local chapters and over 8,700 members, active in such areas as agriculture, community development, health, safety, conservation, international relations, religious activities, governmental affairs, youth in sports and mental health; and
- WHEREAS, through the Jaycees, many opportunities are open for young men between the ages of 21 and 35 to be of service to their communities while developing leadership ability; and
- WHEREAS, membership is open to all young men to learn "that service to humanity is the best work of life;" and
- WHEREAS, the United States Jaycees and its affiliated state and local organizations have set aside the week of January 18 - 24, 1970, to observe Jaycees Week, Founders' Day and their Fiftieth Anniversary; and
- WHEREAS, the civic, business and service organizations of this State recognize that the Jaycees of Minnesota have contributed materially to the betterment of this State,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 18 - 24, 1970, to be


