- WHEREAS, the Educational Secretary believes that the quality of service she renders directly influences the effectiveness of service rendered by the educational agency or institution as a whole,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 19 - 25, 1970, to be

EDUCATIONAL SECRETARIES WEEK


in Minnesota, in recognition of this service to school and community.
