WHEREAS, it is fitting that a period of time be set aside to call attention to this endeavor,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 19-25, 1970, as

YOUTH TEMPERANCE EDUCATION WEEK


in Minnesota, and urge that citizens in churches, schools, organizations and as individuals observe the need for youth temperance education during this time, and continue as a year-round project.
