## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, for the past several years we have been observing a poison prevention campaign designed to reduce accidental poisonings among our young children; and

WHEREAS, in the United States, there has been a steady decline in deaths among youngsters due to poisoning over this period; and

WHEREAS, eeducational programs combined with improved labeling and packaging techniques and medical procedures have all contributed to this decline;

WHEREAS, pharmacists, physicians, teachers, nurses and others have contributed their efforts and knowledge to reduce accidental poisonings; and

WHEREAS, to continue this development,

MOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor 66 the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 15 - 21, 1970, as

## POISON PREVENTION WEEK

in Minnesota, and ask the appropriate agencies of the State, local governments and organizations to cooperate in a coordinated campaign to further reduce this threat to our young people.
