ORDINANCE # 30

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF VICTORIA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. A petition having been filed with the governing body of the Village of Victoria, by James R. Fink Madelyn R. Fink ^{his sister} ~~his sister~~, the owners of the following described real estate, to have such lands included within the Village of Victoria, Minnesota

All that part of Government Lots 3, and 7, Section 12, Township 116 North, Range 24 West Carver County, Minn., described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Government Lot 3; thence Easterly along the North line of said Lot 3 a distance of 230.18 feet; thence deflect 82°29' right a distance of 293.88 feet to an existing iron monument; thence deflect 32°05' left a distance of 408.2 feet; thence deflect 93° 41' right a distance of 502. feet to the centerline of the Town Road and the point of beginning of the tract herein described; thence deflect 180 degrees right a distance of 770.4 feet; thence deflect 109°30' right a distance of 435.6 feet to an existing iron monument; thence deflect 109° 30' left to the shore line of Schutz Lake; thence Southeasterly along said shore line to the east line of said Lot 3; thence Southerly along said East line of Lot 3 and the east line of said Lot 7, to a point on the Southerly boundary of the vacated right of way of the Great Northern Railroad, which point is 921.36 feet Northerly of the Southeast corner of said Lot 7, thence deflect 109° 11' right along said southerly boundary a distance of 622.7 feet to said centerline of town road; thence deflect 28°34' right along said centerline, a distance of 805.68 feet to said point of beginning, containing 18.53 acres, more or less.

Also all that part of Government Lot 2, Section 12, Township 116 North, Range 24 West, Carver County, Minn., described as follows:

Beginning at the east quarter corner of said Section 12; thence Southerly along the east line of said Section 12, to the southeast corner of said Lot 2; thence Westerly along the south line of said Lot 2 a distance of 75.95 feet; thence deflect 70°57' right a distance of 922.68 feet to the southerly boundary of the vacated right or way of the Great Northern Railroad; thence Westerly, along said southerly boundary, to a point on the West line of said Lot 2, which point is 921.36 feet Northerly of the Southwest corner of said Lot 2; thence Northerly, along said West line to the shore line of Schutz Lake; thence generally Southeasterly along said shore line to said East line; thence Southerly, along said East line, to said point of beginning, except a strip of land 100 feet in width, the same being 50 feet in width on each side of the centerline of the Minneapolis and St. Louis Railroad where the same is now located over and across said part of Lot 2 described above, and except as follows:

1. Commencing at a point 305.96 feet Southerly (measured parallel with the East line of Lot 2) and 493.31 feet Westerly (measured parallel with the East-West quarter line of said Section 12) of the east quarter corner of said Section 12; thence South 19°21' East (based on an assumed bearing of due South for the east line of said Lot 2) a distance of 101.6 feet; thence South 61°04' East 117 feet; thence South 25 degrees 18 minutes East 110 feet, more or less, to the Northwesterly right of way line of said Minneapolis and St. Louis Railroad and the point of beginning of the tract herein described; thence North 25°18' West 110 feet; thence North 61°04' West 117 feet; thence North 19° 21' West 101.6 feet; thence South 75°30' West 343 feet; thence North 1°30' West 263 feet; thence North 45°21' East 400 feet, more or less, to the shore line of Schutz Lake; thence generally Southeasterly, along said shore line, to said East line of Lot 2, thence Southerly, along said East line to said Northwesterly right of way; to said point of beginning.

2. That part of the above described tract of land lying Southeasterly of the right of way of the Minneapolis and St. Louis Railroad

Also, all that part of Government Lot 2, Section 12, Township 116, North, Range 24 West, Carver County, Minnesota described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Government Lot 2; thence Westerly along the South line of said Government Lot 2 a distance of 75.95 feet to a point; thence deflect 70° 57' right to the point of intersection with the Northwesterly right of way line of the Minneapolis and St. Louis Railroad; thence Northeasterly along said Northwesterly right of way line to the point of intersection with the East line of said Government Lot 2, thence South along the said East line of Government Lot 2 to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is 33.60 acres.

Section 3. The Village Council hereby determines the above described land is urban in character and that the annexation will be advantageous and in the best interest of the Village of Victoria, Minn., and the land affected; that the land described herein abutts upon the Village of Victoria and is so conditioned so as to be properly subjected to Village Government and improvements.

Section 4. Therefore, the Village of Victoria Minn., hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Victoria, Minn., as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Municipal Commission, the County Auditor; the Secretary of State and the Township Clerk and from and after its passage and publication.
