ORDINANCE NO. 451

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING  
CERTAIN PROPERTY ABUT-  
TING THE CITY OF ANOKA,  
TO THE CITY OF ANOKA.

The Commission of the City  
of Anoka do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to a proper  
and sufficient petition by Jos-  
ephine E. Talbot and L. H. Bol-  
duc Co. Inc., by L. Bolduc, its  
President, the owners of a tract,  
piece and parcel of land abut-  
ting the City of Anoka, Minne-  
sota, and described as follows,  
to-wit:

All that part of Lot 13 of  
Auditor's Subdivision No. 32  
described as follows: Com-  
mencing at the Southwest  
corner of lot 13 thence East  
on South line 578.3 feet;  
thence North at right angles  
280 feet to the Northerly line  
of lot 13 and Southerly line  
of railroad right of way;  
thence Northwesternly on said  
Northerly line of said lot  
13 628.7 feet to Northwest  
corner of lot 13; thence South  
on West line of lot 13 528.5  
feet more or less to point of  
beginning. Except an ease-  
ment over South 30 feet and  
subject to easement to  
Northwestern Bell Telephone  
Company 10 feet wide mea-  
sured at right angles from  
Southerly line of boundary  
of railroad;

to have said territory annexed  
to the City of Anoka, the Com-  
mission having determined that  
the land described in said peti-  
tion abuts on the City of Anoka,  
is not included in any other  
municipality, does not exceed  
200 acres in area, and that the  
annexation to the City of Anoka  
will be the best interests of  
the City of Anoka and of the  
territory described in the peti-  
tion, said tract, piece and parcel  
of land is hereby declared to be  
annexed to and to be an addi-  
tion to the City of Anoka.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall  
be in full force and effect thirty  
(30) days from date of publica-  
tion.
