AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITO OF THE VILLAGE OF EMMONS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND AND UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, A CERTAIN PETITION DATED MARCH 16, 1970, REQUESTING ANNEXATION OF THE TERRITORY MEREINAFTER DESCRIBED WAS DULY PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL ON THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH, 1970; AND

WHEREAS, THE QUANTITY OF LAND EMBRACED IN THE AREA DESCRIBED IN THE PETITION AND BOUNDED AS DESCRIBED TO 120 AGRES OF PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LAND, NO PART OF WHICH IS INCLUDED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF AN INCORPORATED CITY, VILLAGE OR SOROUGH; AND

WHEREAS, THE PETITION WAS SIGNED BY ALL OF THE OWNERS;

WHEREAS, NO OBJECTIONS TO THE ANNEXATION HAVE BEEN RECEIVED FROM THE TOWN BOARD, THE COUNTY BOARD, OR THE GOVERNING BODY OF ANY MUNICIPALITY WHOSE BOUNDARIES ABUTT UPON THE BOUNDARIES OF THE LAND TO BE ANNEXED; AND

THE VILLAGE LIMITS AT THE NORTH BOUNDARY THEREOFS

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EMMONS, MINNESOTA, ORDAING:

SECTION 1. THE VILLAGE COUNCIL HEREBY DETERMINES (1) THAT

THE ANNEXATION WILL BE TO THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE VILLAGE AND OF THE

TERRITORY AFFECTED; (2) THAT THE TERRITORY DESCRIBED HEREIN ABUTTS

UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS AND IS ABOUT TO DECOME URBAN OR BUBURBAN IN

CHARACTER; AND (3) THAT NONE OF SAID TERRITORY IS NOW INCLUDED WITHIN

THE LIMITS OF ANY CITY, VILLAGE OR BOROUGH.

SECTION 2. TERRITORY ANNEXED. THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE ARE HEREBY EXTENSED TO INCLUDE THE PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LAND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, AND THE SAME IS HEREBY ANNEXED TO ANT. INCLUDED BITHIN THE VILLAGE AS EFFECTUALLY AS IF IT HAD ORIGINALLY BEEN A PART THEREOF:

ALL THAT PORTION OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2 IN SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 101 NORTH OF RANGE 22 WEST OF THE 5TH P. M., LESS GOLD TO THE MINNEAPOLIS AND STALOUIS RAILWAY COMPANY FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND LESS THAT PART OF SAID LOT HERETOFORE CONVEYED TO HENRY H. EMMONS BY WARRANTY DEED IN BOOK 36 OF DEEDS, PAGE 322, WHICH LIES EAST OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF U. S. HIGHWAY NO. 69. AND

THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 28; AND

GOVERNMENT LOT 2 AND THAT PART OF GOVERNMENT LOT I LYING EAST AND SOUTH OF THE RAILMOAD RIGHT-OF-WAY IN DECTION 28; AND

Government Lot 1 in Section 33;

ALL IN TOWNSHIP 101 NORTH, RANGE 22 WEST OF THE 57H P. M., LESS AND EXCEPTING A PORTION OF SAID GOVERNMENT LOT 1 DESCRIBED AS LOTS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, AND 10, ARROSHEAD FIRST SUSDIVISION, FREEDORN COUNTY, MINNEGOTA; AND

LOTO 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, AND 10, ARROUNCED FIRST SUBDIVIBION, PREEBORN COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk 10 Hereby Directed to file centified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the Freedorn County Auditor.

SECTION IN EFFECTIVE DATE. THIS ONDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON ITS PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION.
