AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ANNEXATION OF

CERTAIN HEAL ESTATE TO THE

VILLAGE OF STOCKTON

The Village Council of the Village of Stockton, hereby ordains:

That Phillip V. Nicks and Myrtle Nicks, his wife and Daryl Potter and Beverly
Lois Potter, his wife having heretofore submitted to this Council a Petition for
Amnoxition, dated July 22, 1969 for the annexation to said Village of the lands
Aereinafter described, owned by Phillip V. Nicks and Myrtle Nicks, his wife, subject
to the rights of Earyl Potter and Beverly Lois Potter, his wife as contract purchasers
and abutting upon the limits of said Village, and that;

- (1) Phillip V. Nicks and Nyrtle Nicks, his wife are the owners in fee and Daryl Fotter and Deverly Leis Fotter, his wife are contract purchasers of all of said lands excepting lands used by the County for highway purposes, and that said petition has been executed by the above named persons.
- (2) That said land is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres and that copies of said potition have been filed with the Village of Stockton, the town board of Lilsdale Township and the County Board of Winona County and that all of said lands lie within the County of Winona and the Town of Millsdale and abutts upon the Loundaries of the Village of Stockton.
- (3) That thirty days have elapsed from the time of filing said petition and that no objections thereto have been submitted to the Village of Stockton.

That this Council finds that the annexations of said lands are to the best interest of the Municipality and of the territory affected, which territory is

The Southwest Charter of the Northeast Quarter (Sh, of hill), the Southeast marter of the Northwest Quarter (Sh, of Mil) and that part of the Southeast quarter lying North of the Right of way of the Winona and St. Peter Railroad Company (now the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Company). All in Jection Thirty-three (33), Township One Mundred Leven (107) North, Range Light (8) West. Subject to ensements for existing highways and other easements of record.

That this ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Annotated, Section 414.03. Muldivisions I through 3, and shall become officetive upon the publication thereof and upon filing a copy with the Municipal Camalasion State of Minnesota, the County Auditor of Wimona County and the Secretary of State of Minnesota.

AND IT IS MERCHY ORDAINED, by the Village Council of the Village of Stockton, that the above described lands are declared to be annoxed to the Village of Stockton, Ainnesota.
