PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, truly dedicated American citizenship in our proud State is expressed through each individual's constant devotion to the fulfillment and the responsibilities and safeguarding of the privileges inherited with our freedom and democracy; and

WHEREAS, the patriotic unity of our people is today challenged by influences seeking to undermine and destroy our precious freedom; and

WHEREAS, threats to our American way of life can best be counteracted through the forthright reaffirmation of our ideals by all citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the ~~Wednesday~~ of May, 1970, as

LOYALTY DAY

in Minnesota, and urge that every individual, school, church, organization, business establishment and household vigorously reaffirm allegiance to our Flag and Country through active participation in public programs sponsored by the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States and its co-sponsors.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy, and of the State, the one hundred twelfth.
