WHEREAS, the week of April 5 through 11 has been designated as National FHA Week to be observed by the 604,000 members of Future Homemakers of America;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 5 - 11, 1970, as
