WHEREAS, it has been the custom of the State of Minnesota for over twenty years to be represented by Miss Minnesota in the Miss American pageant held annually for the selection of Miss America, and

WHEREAS, the Miss Minnesota Pageant for the selection of Miss Minnesota has been held in Austin, Minnesota for the past five years, and

WHEREAS, the Miss Minnesota Corporation and the Austin Jaycees have established the dates of June 15 through June 20, 1970 as the dates for holding the 1970 Miss Minnesota Pageant which will be held in Austin, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the 1969 Minnesota Legislature by concurrent resolution has formally recognized this annual pageant established in 1935 by designating the reigning Miss Minnesota, Miss Judith Mendenhall and her successors to be selected in the future, as the official Miss Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that said pageant receive the utmost public support and recognition throughout the state of Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 15 through June 20, 1970, as

MISS MINNESOTA WEEK

throughout the State of Minnesota.
