WHEREAS, the Minnesota Business Education Association is oponsoring a Business Education Conference in Moorhead April 24 - 25; and

WHIREAS, the theme of this Conference is "The 70's: Decisive Decade for Business Education;" and

VMEREAS, the observance of this Business Education Conference in cooperation with teachers and educational training institutions on all levels is to give emphasis to the idea of government, business and educators being partners in business education, to help train their young people for careers in the office, distributive, data processing and in the managerial world; and

WHEREAS, the observance of Business Education Week will be climated at the finish annual spring convention of the Hinnesota Business Education Association on the Moorhead State College campus on April 24 and 25, 1970, in honor of the instructors, administrators, exhibitors and representatives of business organizations cooperating in aponsoring this event,
