- WHEREAS, Bob Hope has traveled more than one million miles entertaining U.S. servicemen in the Korean War; and
- WHEREAS, Bob Hope has since 1948 given up his Christmas seasons to entertain troops in all parts of the world; and
- WHEREAS, Bob Hope served as Honorary Chairman of the Week of National Unity in 1969 to rekindle the nation's pride in its achievements; and
- WHEREAS, Bob Hope has received nearly 800 awards and citations for his humanitarian and professional efforts, including the Presidential Medal of Freedom and the Congressional Gold Medal;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 8, 1970 as

BOB HOPE DAY

in Minnesota.
