PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, many handicapped people of the State of Minnesota are now unable to work and live normal lives because of their handicaps; and
- WHEREAS, these people often require the assistance of a vocational rehabilitation service to test and evaluate their abilities and provide training and work experience to make them employable; and
- WHEREAS, a large number of such handicapped people may even need employment opportunity in a rehabilitation workshop because they are not ready for competitive employment; and
- WHEREAS, St. Paul Goodwill Industries provided the evaluation, training and work services needed by handicapped people; and
- WHEREAS, the services of St. Paul Goodwill Industries make possible growth of the abilities of handicapped people to become self-supporting and self-respecting members of the community; and
- WHEREAS, the period of May 3 through May 9, 1970 has been set aside in the nation as Goodwill Week to encourage public support for the international program of Goodwill Industries,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 3 through May 9, 1970 as

MINNESOTA GOODWILL WEEK

and urge all citizens to give their attention and support to the 1970 Goodwill Industries theme - "Goodwill Builds People for Jobs."
