PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Navy Nurses continue to carry out their mission, working in the fields of nursing care, teaching and nursing research, around the world both ashore and afloat, always striving for greater perfection in their chosen profession;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1970 as

NAVY NURSE CORPS MONTH

in recognition of the importance of Navy Nurses to our national defense and our way of life, and I urge the citizens of Minnesota to support the Navy Nurse Corps, its goals and traditions.
