WHEREAS, the American Camping Association has led the nation in spearheading higher standards for all types of camps so that its motto "Better Camping for All" can become a reality;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 1 to May 8, 1970 as
