WHEREAS, the International Institute of St. Paul is observing its fiftieth anniversary year during the week end of May one,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the weekend of May 1-May 2, 1970 as

and call on our citizens to recognize and support the International Institute of St. Paul for its contribution to understanding between ourselves and the diversity of peoples coming to our great State from around the world in search of a new and better life.
