PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota is especially endowed with resources and natural beauty, and

WHEREAS, through the concern and industry of its citizens in the stewardship of natural and human resources, a high level of quality of environment and livability has been achieved, and

WHEREAS, "Gardening with America" is a major emphasis program of the people of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, there is an annual observance of lawn and garden improvement throughout the United States in which all citizens are called upon to participate, and

WHEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 3 through May 9, 1970 as

MINNESOTA LAWN AND GARDEN WEEK

throughout the State of Minnesota, and urge every citizen to pledge himself to do all within his power to assist in the development and improvement of home and community lawns and gardens throughout the State.
