EMBREAS, truly dedicated American citisenship in our proud State is expressed through each individual's constant devotion to the Eulfillment and caseguarding of our inherited freedows, and readiness to defend our national against all enemies, whomspever, and

MEREAS, the patriotic unity of our people in today challenged by un-American influences seeking to undermine and to destroy freedom aroung the world, and

WHEREAS, SUCH THEATS TO THE American way of life can best be countexacted through the forthright patriotic seaffirmation of all of our truly loyal citizens who stand united in the firm defense of our ideals and notion, at all costs and throughout every State of the Union,

NOW, THERMFORE, I, Herold LeVender, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the Elect day of May, 1970 as

LOYALTY DAY

and urge that every individual, school, church, organization and business establishment vigorously reaffirm positive allegiance to our flag and country, through active participation in patriotic public programs eponsored by the Veterans of ForeignsWar of the United States and its co-sponsors.
