WHEREAS, the members of the Square Dance Federation of Minnesota, will have a convention during the month of June in the City of West St. Paul for their nineteenth annual State Square Dance Convention,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 15th through June 21st, 1970 as

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and pay tribute to the fine work of this group in providing wholesome entertainment and encouraging a sense of appreciation of the customs and traditions of our country.
