NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1970, as

in Minnesota, and dedicate this glorious month to the delicious idea of eating more dairy foods, and set aside the month of June to pay tribute to the nation's vast dairy industry - one-fifth of the nation's farm economy - whose daily work and dedication contribute so much to the nation's health and prosperity every day of the year, and propose a milk toast to milk, the beverage that has helped our children grow taller, our young adults more vigorous, and our senior citizens to enjoy the longest, most productive lives in the history of our world.
