NOW, THEREFORE, I, HAROLD LEVANDER, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May to be hearing

in Minnesota, and urge the citizens of this state and the various interested organizations to do all that is fitting and proper to give recognition at this time.
