WHEREAS, many of the outstanding Jewish leaders of our region have been trained in its halls, and

WHEREAS, this institution has stood as a bulwark of positive thinking and learning ing, and

WHEREAS, the Jewish festival of Shavuot, which marks the giving of the Torah at Mount Sinai is celebrated on June 10 and 11,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 8-14, 1970 as

EDUCATION REDEDICATION WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge ~~re~~dedication to the ideals of the Torah which have been a force for everlasting value in Western culture.
