ORDER

The Minnesota Municipal Commission received a petition for the detachment of land from the Village of St. Hilaire, Minnesota, on the 30th day of March, 1970, by the landowners. A resolution for the detachment of the same land was filed by the Village of St. Hilaire on the 30th day of March, 1970.

The territory involved consists of the following:

The South Half of Section One, Township One Hundred Fifty-two North, Range Forty-four West (S $\frac{1}{2}$ Sect 1, T152N, R 44W).

The property is adjacent to the Village of St. Hilaire and said lands are unplatted and used exclusively for agricultural purposes. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minnesota Statutes 414.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the Village of St. Hilaire, and made a part of the Township of Black River, Pennington County, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
