SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER FOR ELECTION

Resolutions of the Villages of Greenwood and Deephaven approving the Order of the Minnesota Municipal Commission of May 15, 1970 were received on the 26th and 27th day of May, 1970 respectively. Pursuant to the receipt of said resolutions and in accordance with the provisions of said Order, the Minnesota Municipal Commission issues its:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

- I. A special election shall be held on the question of the consolidation of the Villages of Greenwood and Deephaven.
 - II. The date of the special election shall be August 4, 1970.
- III. The Village Councils shall conduct the special election in accordance with law.
 - IV. The ballot shall contain the words:

Shall the consolidation of the Villages of Greenwood and Deephaven be approved?

	Yes	No.
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- V. The election judges shall verify and transmit certificates to the Secretary of the Municipal Commission declaring the time and place of the election, that they have canvassed the ballots cast, and the number of "yes" and "no" votes cast.
 - VI. If a majority of the votes are in favor of the consolidation,

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the Secretary shall issue a further Supplemental Order for the election of new Village Officers.

ORDINANCE NO. 1181 (AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1165)

AMENDING AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY OWNED BY THE CITY OF AUSTIN AND ABUTTING THEREON AND TO INCLUDE UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY VALICH IS 75 PERCENT ON MORE BORDERED ON THREE SIDES BY THE CITY OF AUSTIN.

WHREAS, this Ordinance is to correct an error in the wording of the previous ordinance;

AND, WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, vallage or borough; and

WERTAS, the City of Austin is the owner of the land described below and sold premises adjoin the City of Austin and is deemed to be urban in character:

THE COMMON CHINCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: The corporate limits of the City of Austin. Minnesots, are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

- (1) Beginning at a point 475 feet north of the Southwest corner of Section 25, Township 195 North, Range 18 West and in the west line of said Section thence North 1866 feet; thence East 435 feet more or less to the West line of the Chicago Great Western Railroad right-of-way; thence southwesterly along the Chicago Great Western right-of-way to the place of beginning; also the South 18.6 rods of the North half of the Southeast quarter Section 26, Township 183 North, Range 18 West; also the Southwest quarter of the So
- (2) Beginning at the NE corner of the Not Section 9, Township 102 North, Range 18 lest, Mover County, Minnesota, thence southerly along the east line of the said quarter section to a point where this line intersects the centerline of Turtle Creek, thence northwesterly along the centerline of Turtle Creek to a point where said centerline intersects the north line of said quarter section, thence easterly along the north line of said quarter section to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough, and

WMEREAS, this territory is 75 percent or more bordered on three sides by the City of Austin, and is deemed to be urban in character.

WEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Austin served motice of intention upon the Board of Supervisors of Austin Township and Lansing Township, Mover County, Minnesots on May 27, 1969.

WHEREAS, no objections to the ennexation have been received from either Town Board, within the 63 day period as required by Chapter 414.03, Subdivision 2. Minnesota Statutes 1967:

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THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 2: The corporate limits of the City of Austin are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is annexed to and included within the City of Austin as if it had originally been a part thereof:

- (1) Commencing at the Ni corner of the SEt of Section 5, Township 107 North, Hange is Nost, Nover County, Minnesoto, thence southerly 639.1 feet along the west line of said quarter, thence easterly at a dellection angle to the left of 90° 22° a distance of 35 feet to the point of beginning; this point elso being on the east property line of 31st Street 5.W., thence 300 feet easterly along this same ling, thence northorly at a deflection angle to the left of 89° 38° a distance of 275 feet to where it intercepts the south property line of Phillips Patroleum property, thence casterly at a deflection angle to the right of 89° 32° a distance of 2001.2 feet, thence southerly of a deflection angle to the right of 90° 30° a distance of 130 feet, thence easterly at a deflection. earle to the left of 900 00' a distance of 350 feet plus or minus to a point which lies on the west property line of 24th Street S.W., thence southeasterly alone, the west property line of 24th Street S.W. to a point where this line intercepts the mortheast corner of Lot 1. Block 1. Nob Hill let Addition to the City of Austin, this point also lying on the north boundary of Nob Hill let and 2nd Additions, thence westerly along this north boundary line to the northwest corner of Lot 3. Block 1. Nob Hill let Addition, thence coutherly 132 feet along the west property line of seld Lot 3, this point also being on the north right-of-way line of 5th Ave. N.W., thence westerly 66 feet along this north right-of-way to the southeast corner of Lot L. Block 5. Nob Mill lat Addition, thence northerly 132 feet along the east line of said lot to the north boundary line of Nob Hill First and Second Additions, thence westerly along this north boundary line to the Mi corner of Lot 13, Block 6. Nob Hill Second Addition, Mower County, Minnesota, thence southerly along the west line of said Lot 1.d. to the north right-of-way line ith Avanue S.W., thence westerly along the north right-of-way of 5th Avenue S.W. to where it intersects the east right-of-way of 31st Street S.W., thence northerly slong this east right-of-way or Blat Street S.W. to the point of beginning.
- (?) Commencing 63v.1 test south of the NW corner of the SIR of Section 5. Township 10? North, Range 18 West, Mower County, Minnesoto, thence 33 feet easterly at a deflection angle of 90° 22' left to the point of beginning, this point also being on the east Right-of-way line of 31st Street 5.W., thence 300 feet easterly on this same line, thence northerly at a deflection angle to the left of 89° 36° a distance of 775.0 feet, thence westerly at a deflection angle to the left of 90° 22' a distance of 300 feet, this point being on the east property line of 31st Street 5.W., thence southerly along this east property line of 31st Street 5.W., a distance of 275.0 feet to the point of beginning.
- (3) That part of the NV4 of the SD4 of Section 5. Township 102 North, Renge 18 est, described as Tollows: Commencing at the NM corner of the SB4 of Section 5. Township 10. North, Renge 18 West, Mower County, Minnesota, thence east 833.17 feet on the east and west quarter lines of said section, to the point of beginning, thence southerly 360.47 feet at a deflection angle of 60° 45° right, thence easterly 250 feet at a deflection angle of 60° 10° left, thence northerly at a deflection angle to the left of 90° 00°, a distance of 350.32 feet to the east and west quarter line of said section, thence westerly along said section line to the point of beginning.

(5) TRACT A:

All that part of the south half of the NEt of Section 34, Township 103 North, R.nge 18 West, Mover County, Minnesota lying and being east of the centerline of the main channel of the Cedar River as winds and turns except that portion included in the plat of Schleusner and Hortson's Addition to the City of ustin and excepting the following described parcel:

Commencing at the SE corner of the NEA of Section 34, Townohip 103 North, Range 18 west, Mower County, Minnesota, thence west 995 feet along the south line of said quarter, thence northerly 15 feet to the point of beginning, thence north 183 feet along the west boundary line of Schlausner and Martson Addition, thence west 83 feet parallel to the south boundary of said addition, thence south 183 feet parallel to the west boundary of said addition, thence east 83 feet to the point of beginning;

TRACT D:

Commonding of the SW corner of Fehleuener and Hartson Addition to the City of Austin. Winnesota, this point also being on the north line of the SE; of Section 34, Township 103 North, Range 18 west, Mower County, Minnesota, thence westerly clong the north line of said quarter 75 feet plus or minus, to where it intercepts the north-south right-of-way line of federal highway #90, this point being the point of beginning, thence continuing posterly along said north line to where it intercepts the east boundary of Oakwood Cemetary, thence southerly along the east boundary of Oakwood Cemetary to where it intercepts Tederal Highway #90 right-of-way thence casterly and northerly slong Federal Highway #90 right-of-way to the point of beginning.

TRACT C:

Commencing at the SE corner of the NE% of Section 34, Township 103 north, Range 18 West. Mover County, Minnesota, thence west 995 feet along the south line of said quarter, thence northerly 15 feet to the point of beginning, thence north 183 feet along the west boundary of Schleumer and Martson Addition to the City of Austin, thence west 83 feet parallel to south boundary of said Addition, thence south 183 feet parallel to the west boundary of said addition, thence east 63 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 3: The City Recorder is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County in which the property is located, and the Township Clerks of the Townships in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and filing certified copies as directed in Section 3.
