AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF ROCKSBURY, PENNINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA
TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS, MINNESOTA

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

Whereas the following described lands in the Township of Rocksbury, County of Pennington and State of Minnesota are more than Sixty Per Cent (60%) bordered by the City of Thief River Falls and Notice of Intent to Annex the same has been served upon the town board of said township as required by law and no objection has been filed within the time specified by statute, the City Council does, therefore, hereby declare the following described lands to be annexed to the City of Thief River Falls, Minnesota:

A parcel of land which is part of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 4, T.153N, R.43W bounded as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 4; thence westerly along the North line of said Section 4 a distance of 535.6'; thence South a distance of 516'; thence East a distance of 29.6'; thence South a distance of 150'; thence East a distance of 473' to the centerline of Oakland Park Road; thence South along the centerline of Oakland Park Road a distance of 321.6'; thence West a distance of 213'; thence South a distance of 420'; thence East a distance of 213' to the centerline of Oakland Park Road; thence South along the centerline of Oakland Park Road to a point which lies 192.3' North of the South line of the said N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 4; thence Easterly along a line parallel to and 192.3' North of the said South line of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 4 a distance of 703'; thence North along a line parallel to the centerline of Oakland Park Road to an intersection with the centerline of the Red Lake River; thence northerly along the centerline of said River to the North line of said Section 4; thence westerly along the North line of said Section 4 to the point of beginning, containing 43 acres more or less.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing of copies thereof

with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of
Rocksbury Township, the Pennington County Auditor and the
Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
