ORDINANCE NO. 357

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF NORTH, PENNINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA
TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS, MINNESOTA

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby
ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

Whereas the following described lands in the Township of
North, County of Pennington and State of Minnesota are more
than Sixty Per Cent (60%) bordered by the City of Thief River
Falls and Notice of Intent to Annex the same has been served
upon the town board of said township as required by law and no
objection has been filed within the time specified by statute,
the City Council does, therefore, hereby declare the following
described lands to be annexed to the City of Thief River Falls,
Minnesota:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the East
line of Section 28, T.154N, R.43W and the North line
of Block 4, Riverside Addition; thence ^{North} along said
Section line to an intersection with the North line
of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 28; thence
West along said North line to the westerly right-of-
way line of the Soo Line Railroad Company; thence
northwesterly along said right-of-way line to the
center quarter line of said Section 28; thence East
along said quarter line and continuing along the
center quarter line of Section 27 to the centerline
of the Thief River; thence meandering southerly along
the centerline of said River to the North line of
Gov't. Lot 4 of said Section 27 extended; thence West
along said North line to the East line of Dewey Ave.
extended (County State Aid Highway No. 18); thence
South along said East line a distance of 369.6';
thence East along a line parallel to the North line
of Block 2 of Riverside Addition a distance of 295';
thence South along a line parallel to the East line
of Dewey Ave. extended a distance of 295' to the
North line of said Block 2; thence West along the
North line of Riverside Addition to the point of
beginning; containing 75.4 acres more or less.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after
its passage, approval, publication and filing of copies thereof
with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of North
Township, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State
of the State of Minnesota.
