ORDINANCE CORPORATING CERTAIN LANDS SURROUNDED BY THE CITY OF HUTCHINSON, MINNESOTA AND FORMERLY LOCATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HASSAN VALLEY

THE CITY OF HUTCHINSON DOES ORDAIN:

Section I. The following described property owned by Harold Juul is completely surrounded by the City of Hutchinson, Minnesota:

That part of Lot 3 of Auditor's Plat of Section 7 T116N - R 29 W described as follows:
