AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN PLATTED LAND TO BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO, MINNESOTA.

The Common Council of the City of North Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

1. That the following described tract of land is 60% or more surrounded by the municipal boundaries of the City of North Mankato and is hereby deemed urban in character:

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 9 and 10 of Forest Heights Subdivision of a part of Section 10, Township 108 North, Range 27 West, according to the map or plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Nicollet County, Minnesota.

and

Lots 7, 9, 10 and 11 of Pleasantview Subdivision of a part of Section 10, Township 108 North, Range 27 West, according to the map or plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Nicollet County, Minnesota.

and
