An Ordinance Extending the Corporate

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## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS, ITASCA COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the Village at the East boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban in character; and

WHEREAS, this territory is owned in fee by the Village; the Village Council of Grand Rapids ordains:

<u>Section 1. Territory Annexed</u>. The corporate limits of the Village of Grand Rapids are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted property described as follows now owned by the Village:

TRACT 1— Government Lot Four (4), the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4 - SE 1/4) of Section Twenty-Eight (28); Government Lots Five (5), Eight (8) and Nine (9), the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4 - SW 1/4) of Section Twenty-seven (27); the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4 - NW 1/4), the North one-half of the Southwest Quarter (N 1/2 - SW 1/4), the South one-half of the Northwest Quarter (S 1/2 - NW 1/4), the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE 1/4 - SW 1/4), Section thirty-four (34), the East one-hundred sixty-six feet of the North seven-hundred eighty-one feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (E. 166' - N. 781' - NE 1/4 - NE 1/4) of Section thirty-three (33), all contained in Township Fifty-five (55) North, Range Twenty-five (25) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian according to the Government survey thereof, on file and of record in the Office of Register of Deeds of said County and State.

Section 2. Filing. The Village Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.


