**AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION**

Merrill D. Thomson, being duly sworn, on oath says that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been

the publisher of the newspaper known as the Tylor Journal Herald, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the Ordinance No. 50

hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the Village of Tylor, in the County of Lincoln and State of Minnesota, on Wednesday of each week;

That there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Lincoln County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the exact date of the conditions constituting its qualification as a legal newspaper.
