AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

STATE OF MINNESOTA
COUNTY OF LINCOLN

Merlin D. Thompson, being duly sworn, on oath says: that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been

the publisher of the newspaper known as the Tyler Journal Herald, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the Opinionnaire No. 50

longer described, said newspaper was printed and published in the Village of Tylor, in the County of Lincoln and State of Minnesota, on Wednesday of each week;

That during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the Village from which it purports to be issued as above stated and in newspaper format and in column and sheet form exclusively in paper no less than 150 running inches of single columns, two inches wider.

Has been issued once each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the paper.

That the press work on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve has been done in its entire office of publication.

That during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five percent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve.

That during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, photo-matters and reproductions.

Has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office. That a copy of each issue has been filed with the State Library at St. Paul, Minnesota.

That there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Hennepin County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the entire text of the conditions constituting its qualification as a local newspaper.

That the Plaintiff hereinafter mentioned was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published in the English language, once each week, for \$25 successive weeks, and it was first so published on Wednesday, the 13th day of May 1878 and thereafter on Wednesday of each

week to end including the day of , 19 ,
and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from
A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and
kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to wit:


