STIPULATION.

It is hereby stipulated and agreed by and between Hans B. Haroldson, Petitioner in the above entitled matter and John B. Richards, respondent, as follows:

Whereas judgment herein has been entered in the Supreme Court under date of September 4th 1920, affirming the order of the lower court dated August 2nd 1920; and remittitur has been filed in the office of the clerk of the District Court of said Carlton County under the said judgment; and said John B. Richards is proposing to move for a recount of the ballots for the Judgeship cast at the primary election of June 21st 1920; and it is desired by both the interested parties that same be done as soon as practicable;

Now, therefore, it is mutually agreed by the said Haroldson and Richards as follows:

1. The canvass of votes to be made by the State Canvassing Board of Minnesota as required by the order of said court dated August 2nd 1920 and as affirmed by the said judgment of the Supreme Court of the State of Minnesota entered September 4th 1920 is deemed to have been made as of date September 7th 1920; that it declares that Hans B. Haroldson received 400 votes for District Judge in Carlton County, Minnesota at the primary election held June 21st 1920, and that he received more votes than John B. Richards in the 11th Judicial District for judge, and was nominated as one of the judges to be voted on

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at the general November election in 1920; and that it declares that John B. Richards was not nominated as such judge.

It is further stipulated that a copy of this stipulation presented to the Secretary of State shall be deemed full and sufficient authority for him, without further formal action by said State Canvassing Board, to do all the things specified in said order and judgment.

It is further stipulated that time for any contest of said nomination of said Hans B. Haroldson by said John B. Richards shall be deemed to commence to run as of said date, September 7th 1920.; and shall not be deemed to expire until September 17th 1920.

Schmidt, shall do the things required of him by said order with right to assume that the State Department does not and does not intend to receive and under date of September 7th 1920.

Copy of this order presented to said Secretary of State and to said Court Auditor of Carlton County shall be sufficient authority for them and for said two conveying orders to govern themselves accordingly, free from necessity of their further action herein.
