STIPULATION.

It is hereby stipulated and agreed by and between Hans B. Haraldson, Pe-
titioner in the above entitled matter and John B. Richards, respondent, as fol-
lows:

Whereas judgment herein has been entered in the Supreme Court under date
of September 4th 1920, affirming the order of the lower court doted August 2nd
1920; and remittitur has been filed in the office of the clerk of the District
Court of said Carlton County under the said judgment; and said John B. Richards
is preparing to move for a recount of the ballots for the judgeship cast at the
primary election of June 21st 1920; and it is desired by both the interested
parties that same be done as soon as practicable;

Now, therefore, it is mutually agreed by the said Haraldson and Richards
as follows:

I. The recanvass of votes to be made by the State Canvassing Board of Min-
nesota as required by the order of said court doted August 2nd 1920 and as af-
firmed by the said judgment of the Supreme Court of the State of Minnesota en-
tered September 4th 1920 is dooned to have have been made as of date September
7th 1920; that it declares that Hans B. Haraldson received 400 votes for Dis-
trict Judge in Carlton County, Minnesota at the primary election held June 21st
1920, and that he received more votes than John B. Richards in the II th Judi-
cial District for judge, and was nominated as one of the judges to be voted on

at the general November election in 1930; and that it declares that John B. Richards was not nominated as such judge.

It is further stipulated that a copy of this stipulation presented to the Secretary of State shall be deemed full and sufficient authority for him, without further formal action by said State Canvassing Board, to do all the things specified in said order and judgment.

It is further stipulated that time for any contest of said nomination of said Hans S. Haraldson by said John B. Richards shall be deemed to commence to run as of said date, September 7th 1930.; and shall not be deemed to expire until September 17th 1930.

On reading following the within and annexed stipulation of Hans B. Ny-

said proceeding be and they are hereby released and discharged from necessar-
ity of further action herein, or under the order of the court herein made and
dated August 2nd 1920; commanding that the Secretary of State, Julius A.
Schmidl, shall do the things required of him by said order with right to re-
quest that the State Publishing Board has and recommends no revised and
dated date of September 7th 1920.

Copy of this order presented to said Secretary of State and to said County
Auditor of Carlton County shall be sufficient authority for them and for said
two newspaper bases to cover themselves accordingly, free from necessity
of their further action herein.
