ACCEPTING RETIREMENT APPLICATION OF THE HONORABLE SAM G. GANDRUD

WHEREAS,

The Honorable Sam G. Gandrud, Judge of the District Court, Eighth Judicial District, State of Minnesota, attained the age of 70 years on April 18, 1970 and,

WHEREAS,

Judge Gandrud has served as Judge of the District Court since the first Monday in January, 1953 and,

WHEREAS.

Judge Gandrud, under date of April 20, 1970, submitted his written application for retirement pursuant to

M. S. 490.101 and,

WHEREAS,

Judge Gandrud has, in writing, waived the compensation allotted to his office from the date of his retirement to the date of the expiration of the term for which he was elected.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That having determined that said Judge Sam G. Gandrud is eligible for retirement, it is hereby ordered that the application by Judge Gandrud for retirement as here and before recited shall be accepted and his retirement for the unexpired portion of his term is hereby directed effective September 1, 1970. It is further ordered that a copy of this order be filed with the Secretary of State and the State Auditor together with a copy to the Honorable Sam G. Gandrud.

My Dear Governor:

I respectfully apply to retire under the provisions of 490.101, subdivision 1, of the Minnesota Statutes, as a Judge of the District Court of this State effective as of the close of the 31st day of August, 1970. May I therefore request that you direct my retirement beginning on the 1st day of September, 1970, by a written order to be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State. A duplicate of this letter is enclosed to be filed with the order.

I am eligible to so retire because of the following facts. I was born on the 18th day of April, 1900. A certified copy of my birth certificate is enclosed. I was elected as a District Judge of the Twelfth Judicial District of Minnesota at the general election in November, 1952, and qualified as such and have served continuously in the office ever since the first Monday of January, 1953, having been elected again in 1958 and 1964. The term of office for which I was last elected will expire on Monday, the 4th day of January, 1971. I have never served as a judge of a court of record other than the aforesaid service as a District Judge. I have served as a District Judge, as you will note, for a period of more than seventeen years, which with my attained age makes me eligible for retirement at this time.

As required by Section 490.102, subdivision 1, as amended, of the Minnesota Statutes, and in order that I may receive retirement pay of one-half the compensation alloted to the office of District Judge from and after the 1st day of September, 1970, during the remainder of my life I hereby waive payment of the full compensation allotted to the office from the 1st day of September, 1970, to the 4th day of January, 1971, being the expiration of the term for which I was last elected as such Judge.
