Ordinance No. 222

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHANGING THE REGULAR ELECTION DATE
IN THE VILLAGE OF MINNEOTA, LYNN COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Minneota ordains as follows:

1. Pursuant to law affecting the right of the Village Council to change the regular Village Election Day to correspond with State elections, be it so noted that the Council passes this ordinance.
2. Village Elections will be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, commencing with the election in the year 1970.
