State of Minnesota County of Micolles ORDINANCE NO. 44 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN LANDS ABUTTENG UPON NICOLLET VILLAGE". G. R. Preston being duly sworn, on oath says; that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the Publisher The Village Council of Nicollet publisher of the newspaper known as The Nicollet Leader Minnesota, do ordain as follows: Section 1. That the lands presently abutting upon the southerly corporate limits of said Village, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication Ordinance corporate limits of said Villag described as follows, to-wit:
