ORDINANCE NO. 44

"AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN LANDS ABUTTING UPON NICOLLET VILLAGE".

The Village Council of Nicollet, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:
Section 1. That the lands presently abutting upon the southerly corporate limits of said Village, described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Three (3), in Township One Hundred and Nine (109) North of Range Twenty-Eight (28) West, lying North of the North right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway and U. S. Highway Fourteen (14), and West of the Southerly extension of the East line of Elm Street, in the Village of Nicollet, Nicollet County, Minnesota, and containing Twenty-Four & 5/10 (24.5) Acres of Land, more or less, are hereby annexed to Nicollet Village, and included within the corporate limits of said Village.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.

Passed by the Village Council of Nicollet Village, Minnesota, this 5th day of December, A. D. 1955.

being duly sworn, on oath says;

that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the Publisher publisher of the newspaper known as The Nicollet Leader and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the Ordinance

hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the village of Nicollet, in the County of Nicollet

State of Minnesota, on Friday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the village

from which it purports to be issued as above stated and in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued once

each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and equipped with the necessary material for preparing and printing the same, and the presswork on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community which it purports to serve has been done in its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office; and that there has been

on file in the office of the County Auditor of Nicollet County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper.

That the Ordinance hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for one successive weeks: that it was first so published on Friday

the 9th day of March 1956; and thereafter on Friday

of each week to and including the 9th day of March 1956; and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from a to z both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:
