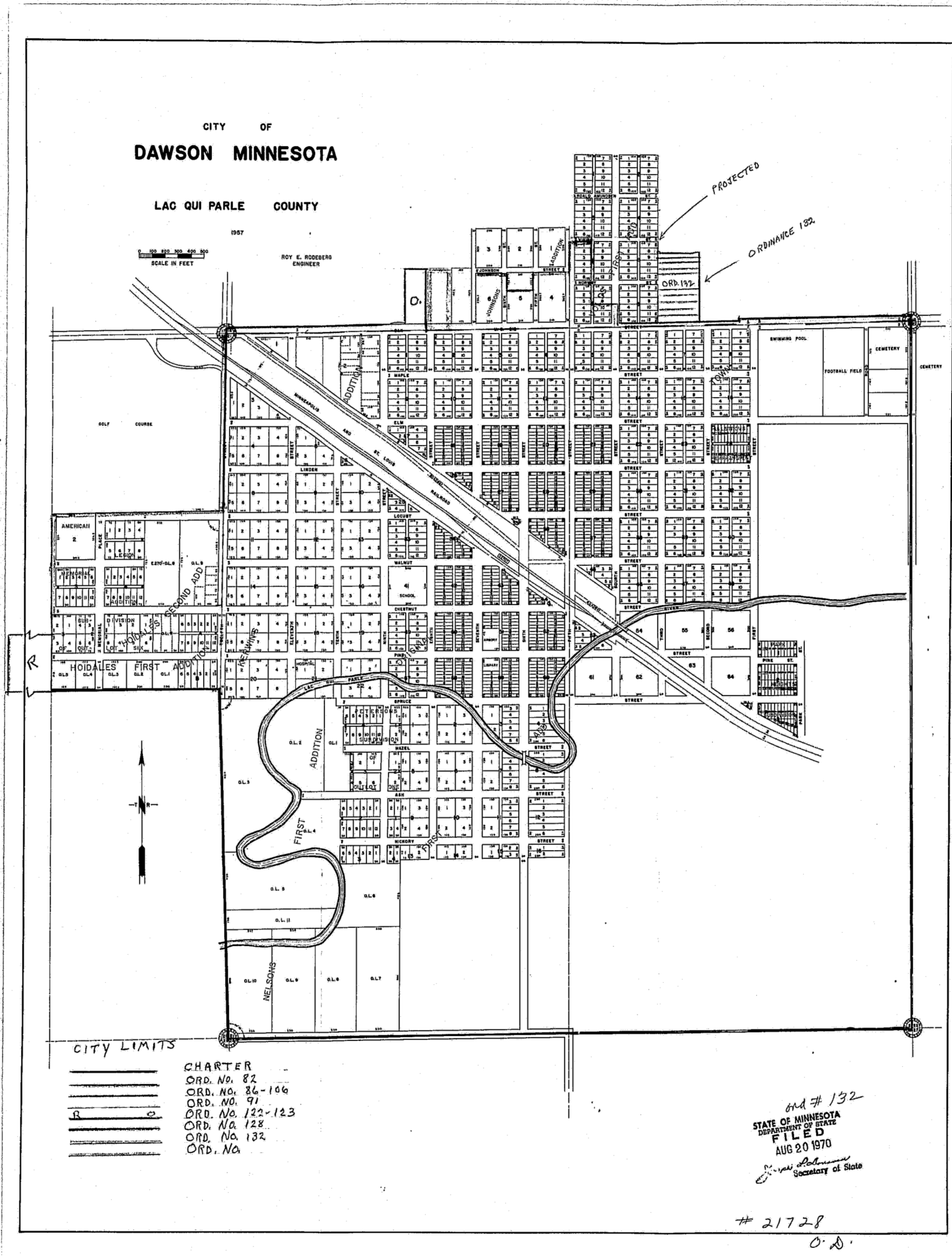

ORDINANCE NO. 132  
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING  
TERRITORY AND EXTENDING  
CITY LIMITS.

The City Council of the City of  
Dawson, Minnesota, does hereby or-  
dain as follows:

Section 1. That it is hereby  
found and determined that that tract  
of land situated in Lac Qui Parle  
County, Minnesota, described as  
follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point that is 349.4  
feet West of and 33 feet North  
of the Southeast Corner of the  
Southwest Quarter of the South-  
east Quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) of Sec-  
tion Sixteen (16) in Township one  
Hundred Seventeen North (117N),  
of Range Forty-Three West (43W),  
running thence North at right an-  
gles to the South sectionline for a  
distance of 545 feet, running thence  
West at right angles for a dis-  
tance of 282 feet, to the East line  
of Vold's First Addition to the  
City of Dawson, thence South at  
right angles along the East line  
of Vold's First Addition for a  
distance of 545 feet, thence East  
at right angles to the point of  
beginning,

abuts the northerly city limits of the  
City of Dawson and is so situated  
and conditioned as to be the proper  
subject of urban government, and  
that it is adapted for use as a com-  
mercial district, and that it is to  
the best interests of the City of  
Dawson and of said above de-  
scribed territory that it be annexed  
to the City of Dawson for all govern-  
mental purposes.

SECTION 2. That it is also here-  
by found and determined that the  
petition of the owners of said prop-  
erty, praying for such annexation,  
was duly filed with the City of Daw-  
son, the Town of Riverside, the  
County of Lac Qui Parle and with  
Minnesota Municipal Commission,  
together with copies of the res-  
olution of the City of Dawson con-  
sistent to such annexation, pursuant  
to the provisions of Section 414.033,  
Subd. 5 of Minnesota Statutes An-  
notated, and that no objections  
thereto have been presented or  
filed.

SECTION 3. That all of said tract  
described in Section 1 herof, to-  
gether with that part of Trunk Hi-  
ghway No. 212 adjacent thereto, is  
hereby annexed to the City of Daw-  
son for all governmental purposes  
and that the city limits of the City  
of Dawson are hereby extended and  
enlarged to include the same, and  
that all thereof is hereby zoned as  
Commercial District property, and  
is assigned to and made a part of  
the First Ward of the City  
of Dawson.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance  
shall be in effect from and after  
final passage and publication and  
that true and correct copies there-  
of shall be forwarded to and filed  
with Minnesota Municipal Com-  
mission, the County Auditor of Lac  
Qui Parle County, Minnesota, and  
the Secretary of State of the  
State of Minnesota, as provided by  
Rule 16 (a) of Minnesota Muni-  
cipal Commission Rules of  
Practice.

# PRINTERS AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

STATE OF MINNESOTA, } ss.

Norman Bacon, being duly sworn, on oath, says he is and during all the times  
herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as Daw-  
son Sentinel, and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said  
newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column  
and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said  
newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said news-  
paper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the com-  
munity which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other pub-  
lication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements.  
(4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to  
serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an  
average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three  
months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office.  
(5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Dawson in the County of Lac  
qui Parle and it has its known office of issue in the City of Dawson in said county,  
established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news,  
sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by publisher of  
said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control dur-  
ing all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed (6)  
Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical  
Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for  
at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8)  
Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to  
January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed  
by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of newspaper, and sworn  
to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

He further states on oath that the printed Ordinance 132 Annexing

and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week,

ORDINANCE NO. 132.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY AND EXTENDING CITY LIMITS.

The City Council of the City of Dawson, Minnesota, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it is hereby found and determined that that tract of land situated in Lac Qui Parle County, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point that is 349.4 feet West of and 33 feet North of the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Sixteen (16) in Township One Hundred Seventeen North (17 N), of Range Forty-Three West (43 W), running thence North at right angles to the south section line for a distance of 545 feet, running thence West at right angles for a distance of 282 feet, to the East line of Vold's First Addition to the City of Dawson, thence South at right angles along the East line of Vold's First Addition for a distance of 545 feet, thence East at right angles to the point of beginning,

abuts the northerly city limits of the City of Dawson and is so situated and conditioned as to be the proper subject of urban government, and that it is adapted for use as a commercial district, and that it is to the best interests of the City of Dawson and of said above described territory that it be annexed to the City of Dawson for all governmental purposes.

Section 2. That it is also hereby found and determined that the petition of the owners of said property, praying for such annexation, was duly filed with the City of Dawson, the Town of Riverside, the County of Lac Qui Parle and with Minnesota Municipal Commission, together with copies of the resolution of the City of Dawson consenting to such annexation, pursuant to the provisions of Section 414.033, Subd. 5 of Minnesota Statutes Annotated, and that no objections thereto have been presented or filed.

Section 3. That all of said tract described in Section 1 hereof, together with that part of Trunk Highway No. 212 adjacent thereto, is hereby annexed to the City of Dawson for all governmental purposes and that the city limits of the City of Dawson are hereby extended and enlarged to include the same, and that all thereof is hereby zoned as Commercial District property, and is assigned to and made a part of the First Ward of the City of Dawson.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after final passage and publication and that true and correct copies thereof shall be forwarded to and filed with Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Lac Qui Parle County, Minnesota, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as provided by Rule 16 (a) of Minnesota Municipal Commission Rules of Practice.
